



Team Coach Guidelines

- Help players develop skill and positive attitudes to physical activity, sport and water polo.
- Maintain a sound knowledge of the rules and skills of water polo and organise team players so that they gain benefit from involvement.
- Be aware of the various Codes of Conduct, rules and regulations and implement and support those Codes at all times.
- Appoint a team manager immediately after sign-on or liaise with appointed manager.
- Arrange and plan with manager suitable training sessions leading up to competition.
- Correlate player profile forms collected by manager (forms to be supplied by the Management Committee).
- Encourage players and team support officials to abide by the rules of water polo at all times.
- Encourage support and respect for the Codes of Conduct of the association and QWPI, both on and off the field.
- Complete reports for teams within 14 days of completion of tournaments or competitions to the Sunshine Coast Management Committee (report forms to be supplied by the Management Committee prior to selection on request or upon selection).
- Liaise regularly with the Development Officer.
- Have a good working knowledge of the association constitution, rules, policies and procedures.
- Be aware of the future directions of the association.
- Undertake training and updates to achieve and retain appropriate qualifications.
